## 2010 Annual Meeting Minutes

Date: August 28, 2010

Place: Pocatello, Idaho

Recorded by Jerry D. Smith

President Brian Poole called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and welcomed all.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Brian held a moment of silence for all of those who are no longer with us.

The minutes of the 2009 meeting were published in the Four Dead and were passed out. The reading of the minutes was dispensed with. Melanie Poole made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Dale Oberg seconded. Motion passed.

Jerry Smith passed out the financial report and went over the high points. The balance at the end of 2010 is \$1,479.66. This is about \$500.00 higher than the ending 2009 balance. Bob Zausch made a motion to accept the financial report as presented. Don Titcomb seconded. Motion passed.

There were no reports under Vice President's reports, Gary Kollmann said he would share some thoughts later.

Statistician Jerry Smith stated that all went well this year and that everything is done in HSMaster which is the way the NHPA prefers it. In fact, Jerry LaBrosse at the charter meeting at World Tournament stated that NATSTATS wants all charters to be using HSMaster asap.

The acting Sec-Treas., Jerry Smith stated he was doing the job for the elected Sec/Treas. David Spears due to personal problems clouding David's ability to perform the duties. David asked that he continue into next year. Nothing else was reported on. Jerry did state that Idaho's membership was at 122 which is down from last year's total of 134.

President Brian spoke about wanting everyone to promote the sport by getting more pitchers involved. He said that this year was uneventful and that he was available by email if anyone had a problem or a suggestion.

Under correspondence, Jerry said there was none

Gary Kollmann stated that the World Tournament Convention was uneventful and that Knoxville, Tennessee was selected as the 2012 World Tournament site.

Under old business; David Spears made motion to send the webmaster, Steve Summerlin, \$50.00 as thanks for his work. Nick Piva seconded. Motion passed.

The newsletter will be out in September because Jerry was at the WT and didn't have time to complete one. No action.

Under new business, Brian encouraged to get their schedule into to Jerry Smith by the first or so of December. He wants it completed by the first of February. No action.

Dave Spears spoke about his proposed Hall of Fame By-Law which was handed out. He then read the By-Law it was discussed. Don Titcomb made a motion to accept the By-Law and put it the ISHPA By-Laws. Bob Zausch seconded. Motion Passed.

David Spears made a motion that Pocatello host the Idaho State Doubles in 2011. Jerry Smith seconded. Motion passed.

Glen Wessel made a presentation about Coeur d Alene's facilities and their desire to host the 2011 State Single Tournament. After some discussion, Melanie Poole made a motion that Coeur d Alene host the 2011 State Singles Tournament. Nick Piva seconded. Motion passed. Glen stated that the Tournament would held on August 27th and 28th

Brian Poole was re-elected as President for the next 2 years by acclamation.

David Spears nominated Brent Wood for 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President... Dale Oberg seconded. Brent was elected 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President for the next two years.

Gary Kollmann then spoke about an idea to get more people to the annual meeting. He suggested the meeting take place at 9:00am on the day of the State Single Tournament. No action  
Brian declared the meeting adjourned at around 7:30 pm.

## Regional Director Message:

Below is information I feel need s to be brought forth based on my observations.

**2. Conditional Court Sanction** All courts constructed *before* January 1, 2007 *must meet the basic court requirements of:* 1) correctly marked foul lines, 2) minimum pit dimensions, 3) specified stake diameter and placement, 4) specified stake height and angle/lean, 5) legal pit material of minimum depth, and **6) a protective barrier surrounding the courts.**

**Where Protective Barrier** means: For safety reasons, all court complexes shall be surrounded by a protective barrier. This barrier should be at least eight feet (8') behind the stakes. A chain-link type of fence at least four feet (4') high is recommended.

Note: A protective barrier can be anything from a fence to a rope that isolates the courts from the spectators and others not pitching, if no protective barrier is in place throughout tournament play all insurability by the NHPA will be lost for that tournament.

### Section C – Awards

All Junior Cadet and Junior play (mixed class or otherwise) will be conducted on an amateur basis. Awards presented to these Divisions by the Tournament/League Officials should have no immediate monetary value.

### Section D – Responsibility

It shall be the responsibility of all Junior Cadet and Junior pitchers (or their parents/guardians) to make sure that their

amateur standing is not jeopardized by any violation of the above information.

### **During Horseshoe Tournaments**

a. During sign-in, verify that all entrants are current NHPA members. b. Arrange for scorekeeping for each court. c. Appoint an official judge(s) and provide them with judging tools, and a copy of the current RGS book.

Before class play begins:

- a. Announce the method of play (cancellation or count-all)
- b. Announce how winners will be determined, and how ties and class ties will be broken.
- c. Announce the amount and method for paying scorekeepers (if used).
- d. If scoring devices are used, provide the contestants with a name placard.
- e. Provide a schedule and/or round-robin card of games to be played, including court assignments.
- f. Have statisticians available for the checking and recording of game scores and for the compilation of class results, as the tournament proceeds.
- g. Make the final decisions on any protests, and answer any questions that may arise.
- h. When necessary, make the decision to halt play due to inclement weather or other emergencies and decide when play shall resume, if or when conditions improve.
- i. Present the awards at the end of play.

I hope that everybody weathers well throughout the rest of the year and I hope to see many of you in the 2011 season.

## **Viewpoint**

I would like to comment on this year's State Championships that were held in Pocatello, Idaho. I have been a member of the Idaho State Horseshoe Pitching Association for the last 15-18 years, and before that I was a member of the Arizona and California Associations, putting the total number of years in NHPA organized horseshoe pitching at about 30 years. I am passionate about the sport and work very hard at trying to improve my skills. I have put on tournaments and donated to tournaments in both money and prizes, as well as help getting many pitchers from other states over to Idaho to pitch.

I have pitched in 8 World Championships and frequently pitch in Oregon and Washington, so I think I have the experience and knowledge to make some observations about our State Championships.

I want to thank Brian and Jerry for their help, and Brian's wife Melanie for her help. It is refreshing to see a couple like Melanie and Brian involved in this sport together. I know it is a thankless job and I do appreciate their involvement.

With that being said I feel I need to say a few things regarding this year's tournament and hopefully we can get BACK to running a state tournament the way it has been run in the past and hopefully even better in the future. The leadership should insist on scorekeepers for ALL PITCHERS! To me it is not acceptable to force or allow pitchers to keep their own scores in this so called top tournament for our State. I do not know of any

other State that will allow this to happen. It seems to me that maybe we are more interested in getting the tournament over with instead of making this the best tournament of the year like it should be. If my wife did not keep score for 3 courts the top class who are pitching for the men's title would not have had anybody to score! Would we have been expected to keep our own score? It is not only wrong to have 1 person keep score for 3 courts but very unfair for that person. This problem could have been easily rectified if some were not more interested in getting the tournament over with and been more interested in what this tournament is about! Any number of classes could have waited to pitch until later in the afternoon so that all pitchers could have score keepers.

The other problem I saw was the courts were in horrible shape. The clay was dry and had not been turned or worked into shape. Shovels and paint were scarce. This is the host cities responsibility and they should be held accountable. If Pocatello does not want to put forward the effort in putting on a quality tournament, or if there is not enough members that will help get courts ready, they should not bid on having it. What happened to Tee Shirts? I have some from previous state tournaments? What about a 50/50 drawing? What about donuts and coffee in the morning? What about Judges? Payouts are way down due to the lack of participants throughout the year that contributes to the state tournament fund.

Overall this is the worst representation of a State Championship Tournament that I have been involved with. Maybe we should get back to basics and start treating this sport with the respect it deserves so we can all enjoy the fruits of our passion.

On another note to our leadership, drop the Hall of Fame! It is ridiculous to even think about adding another responsibility to a struggling organization. We should be concentrating on fixing the current lack of involvement, and membership issues, and work on building this organization back to where it was just a few years ago. A Hall of Fame is not the responsible thing to be doing at this time.

Coeur d'Alene - I hope your tournament is as good as the last one you hosted, it was well run and very enjoyable. I am glad to see it back north.
